- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

- 3 SECTION 1. HANDBOOK TO IMPROVE LEASING PROJECTS.
- 4 (a) UPDATE.—Not later than 180 days after the date
- 5 of the enactment of this Act, and not less than once every
- 6 five-year period thereafter, the Secretary of Veterans Af-
- 7 fairs shall update the handbook of the Department of Vet-
- 8 erans Affairs titled "Planning and Activating Community
- 9 Based Outpatient Clinics", or a successor handbook, to

- 1 reflect current policies, best practices, and clarify the roles
- 2 and responsibilities of the personnel of the Department in-
- 3 volved in the leasing projects of the Department.
